

## Directions for watching ProMade PoC Center 360 VR Video

**Best if viewed** from an iPad, mobile device, or a computer/laptop with a touch screen.

**To retain the intended primary view** and not miss key equipment and features in the ProMade PoC Center, when you see an image or video show up on the edge of your view, you should move the view to see that image.

- ▶ **Feel free to move anywhere** in the video to discover the whole ProMade PoC Center.
- ▶ **If you are looking at the “back”** of a room when the video changes to another room, you will be looking at the “back” of the next room.

## Device Specific Directions

**Viewing from an iPad** or mobile device with positioning capabilities

- ▶ **The position of your device** when opening YouTube sets the Primary Angle / View of any VR video opened on YouTube.  
For example, if you open YouTube with device on a desk and then lift the device to view, view will shift from looking forward to looking up in the video.
- ▶ **To change the view**  
**Option 1:** Move your device like you would move your head to see another area of a room.  
**Option 2:** Move your finger on the touch screen. For example, to view items to the right, you must “Pull” that area into view by moving your finger from right to left.

**Viewing from a computer with a touch screen** and no positioning capabilities.

- ▶ **To change the view**, move your finger on the touch screen. For example, to view items to the right, you must “Pull” that area into view by moving your finger from right to left.

**Viewing on a computer with no touch screen** capabilities

- ▶ **To change the view**, use your mouse to click on the video and move the mouse to change view. For example, to view items to the right, you must “Pull” that area into view by moving the mouse from right to left.
